


PEACE TRAIN PROCESSION LOS ANGELES, CA TO SAN JOSE, CA

DR. ARUN GANDHI

CREDENTIALS

Dr. Arun Gandhi is the co-founder of the Gandhi King Season for Nonviolence, and the M.K. Gandhi Institute for Nonviolence. Born in 1934 in Durban, South Africa, Arun is the fifth grandson of India's legendary leader, Mohandas K. "Mahatma" Gandhi. Growing up under the discriminatory apartheid laws of South Africa, he was beaten by "white" South Africans for being too black and "black" South Africans for being too white; so, Arun sought eye-for-an-eye justice. However, he learned from his parents and grandparents that justice does not mean revenge, it means transforming the opponent through love and suffering. Arun continues to share these lessons all around the world. The M.K. Gandhi Institute for Nonviolence was founded in 1991 Arun and his wife, Sunanda. For the past five years, he has participated in the Renaissance Weekend deliberations with President Clinton and other well-respected Rhodes Scholars. Arun and Sunanda travel almost year-round all over the world speaking and teaching about nonviolence and promoting the work of the Gandhi Institute



YOLANDA KING

CREDENTIALS

Yolanda King is the first-born daughter of Coretta Scott King and Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. She is the Founder and CEO of Higher Ground Productions, a dynamic voice among twenty-first century speakers. Yolanda's mission is to encourage personal growth and positive social change through her artistic endeavors, including acting, producing, speaking and teaching. It is King's passion for peace and positive change that prompted her vision for founding Higher Ground Productions, an organization dedicated to teaching people to celebrate diversity and embrace unity. Yolanda King has performed or lectured in 49 US states as well as in Europe, Africa and Asia for educational, business, religious and civic organizations. She is the co-author of *Open My Eyes, Open My Soul*, which demonstrates her commitment to raise awareness and enhance understanding about the importance of diversity. In an effort to help groups and individuals find more personal freedom, King has joined forces with a Life Coach and created her new book entitled *Embracing Your Power in 30 Days, a Journey of Self-Discovery and Personal Freedom.*



DISTINGUISHED PRESENTERS INCLUDE:

ELA GANDHI

CREDENTIALS

Mrs. Ela Gandhi is a former member of Parliament in the Republic of South Africa. A qualified social worker by profession, Ela Gandhi has been driven by a community spirit of social and political activism since her childhood. She consistently works to ensure that the voices of the voiceless are heard, directing her work as a South African activist towards raising the issues of the oppressed. Working as a social worker, Mrs. Gandhi was put on house arrest for 8 years after attempting to mobilize the community to take up their own issues. During the RSA negotiations process she was selected as one of the representatives of her organization to represent the people. She was then selected to be on the list of candidates for parliament and was sent to parliament for two terms, resigning from parliament in January 2003. At present, she is Editor and Chairperson of the Board of management of Satyagraha - In pursuit of Truth - a nonprofit organization, which runs a newspaper promoting Gandhian ideals. She is secretary of the Gandhi Development Trust, chairperson of the Domestic Violence Help Line, the Mahatma Gandhi Handicraft Centre, and Trustee of the Mahatma Gandhi Trust which was donated to the Natal Indian Congress when Gandhi left South Africa in 1914. She is a member on the Advisory Boards of Unilever Ethics Centre, International Advisory Board of the World Parliament of Religions and Advisory Board of the Ahimsa Centre, in California. She is Vice President of the South African Chapter of World Conference on Religion and Peace and is on the ANC's Commission on Religious Affairs.



DR. BERNARD LAFAYETTE, JR., ED.D. CREDENTIALS

Dr. Bernard LaFayette, Jr. is the director of the Center for Nonviolence and Peace Studies. LaFayette has been a Civil Rights Movement activist, minister, educator, lecturer, and is an authority on the strategy on nonviolent social change for over 40 years. In 1960, he co-founded the Student Nonviolent Coordinating Committee (SNCC). He was a leader of the 1960 Nashville Movement, on the Freedom Rides, and the 1965 Selma Movement. He directed the Alabama Voter Registration Project in 1962, and he was appointed National Program Administrator for the Southern Christian Leadership Conference (SCLC) and National Coordinator of the 1968 Poor Peoples' Campaign by Martin Luther King, Jr. In addition, Dr. LaFayette has served as Director of Peace and Justice in Latin America; Chairperson of the Consortium on Peace Research, Education and Development; Director of the PUSH Excel Institute; and minister of the Westminster Presbyterian Church in Tuskegee, Alabama. Dr. Lafayette is an ordained minister who earned his B.A. from the American Baptist Theological Seminary in Nashville, Tennessee. Lafayette also received his Ed. M. and Ed. D. from Harvard University.



DISTINGUISHED PRESENTERS INCLUDE:

DR. A.T. ARIYARATNE

CREDENTIALS

Dr. Ariyaratne is the founder and president of the Sarvodaya Shramadana Movement in Sri Lanka. Based on Buddhist and Gandhian principles, the Sarvodaya Movement was founded by Ariyaratne 47 years ago, and is now the world's largest spiritually-based people's development movement working in 15,000 villages in Sri Lanka. Dr. Ariyaratne works for social and economic justice for the poorest of the poor in Sri Lanka and in the world. Sarvodaya means "the awakening of all" and Shramadana means sharing. The essence of the movement is that "Everybody Wakes Up through Sharing Labor, Energy, Resources, and Love." Dr. Ariyaratne has described the goal of Sarvodaya as a "dual awakening": the awakening of the individual and the awakening of society. Sarvodaya has mobilized tens of thousands of people to create housing, water projects, solar energy, food production, pre-school programs, legal services, women's projects, orphanages, child welfare agencies, village banks, and more. Dr. Ariyaratne has also led some of the world's largest peace marches and meditations to address the conflict in his country, with 650,000 people gathering in Sri Lanka in 2004. For his development work and his peace activities, Dr. Ariyaratne has received numerous international awards, including: the Magsaysay Award for Community Leadership from the Philippines (1969), the King Boudouin Award for International Development from Belgium (1982), the Niwano Peace Prize from Japan (1992), and the Mahatma Gandhi Peace Prize from the Government of India (1996). Working with all religions and all ethnic groups, Dr. Ariyaratne has described Sarvodaya as "the essence of religion", because it seeks to unite all people to work together to build a nonviolent and cooperative society.




DR. MARSHALL ROSENBERG

CREDENTIALS

Dr. Marshall Rosenberg is the founder and director of educational services for the Center for Nonviolent Communication. Growing up in a turbulent Detroit neighborhood, Dr. Rosenberg developed a keen interest in new forms of communication that would provide peaceful alternatives to the violence he encountered. His interest led to a doctorate in clinical psychology from the University of Wisconsin in 1961, where he studied under Carl Rogers. His subsequent life experience and study of comparative religion motivated him to develop the Nonviolent Communication (NVC) process. He founded the Center for Nonviolent Communication in 1984, an international nonprofit peacemaking organization, which is now affiliated with more than 180 certified NVC trainers in 35 countries around the globe. Dr. Rosenberg is the author of Speak Peace in a World of Conflict, and the bestselling Nonviolent Communication: A Language of Life. He is the 2006 recipient of the Global Village Foundation's Bridge of Peace Award, and the Association of Unity Churches International 2006 Light of God Expressing Award. He is also an Honorary Board member of the International Coalition for the Decade for the Promotion of a Culture of Nonviolence and Peace for the Children of the World, a position shared with Nobel Peace Prize Laureates, Desmond Tutu and the Dalai Lama. Rosenberg spends more than 250 days each year traveling the globe, teaching his world-renowned Nonviolent Communication (NVC) process in hundreds of local communities, at national conferences, and in some of the most impoverished, war-torn states of the world.


